



A designated Club Contact is the main point of contact for each Club and any changes to the Club's membership (ie addition of new members or removal of existing) must be authorised by the Club Contact. The annual membership renewal is issued to the club 6-8 weeks in advance of the club's renewal date. The club contact must then amend the list (deleting non-renewing members and adding new members' details) and return to the IFA Countryside Office, Farm Centre, Mill Park Road, Enniscorthy, Co Wexford.
